We, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and Ex-Officio County Board of Canvassers for Polk County, do hereby certify the following to be a true and correct abstract of the votes cast in this county at the Bondurant-Farrar Special School Election held on the 2nd day of February, 2016, as shown by the tally lists returned by the election precincts in the Bondurant-Farrar Community School District.

PUBLIC MEASURE LETTER A

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Bondurant-Farrar Community School District in the Counties of Polk and Jasper, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$21,000,000 to provide funds to construct, build, furnish and equip additional instructional space and a performing arts auditorium to the existing high school building and to improve the site; and to construct, build, furnish and equip additional instructional space to Morris Elementary and building to improve this site?

FOR THE MEASURE, THERE WERE	730 Votes
AGAINST THE MEASURE, THERE WERE	<u>180 Votes</u>
Total	910 Votes

WE THEREFORE DECLARE: THE MEASURE WAS APPROVED.

PUBLIC MEASURE LETTER B

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Bondurant-Farrar Community School District in the Counties of Polk and Jasper, State of Iowa, for the purpose of purchasing and improving grounds; constructing schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; purchasing of buildings; purchase, lease or lease-purchase of technology and equipment; paying debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; renting facilities under Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings or equipment; purchasing equipment authorized by law; or for any purchase or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, as determined by the board, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed One Dollar Thirty-Four Cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019?

FOR THE MEASURE, THERE WERE	745 Votes
AGAINST THE MEASURE, THERE WERE	<u>172 Votes</u>
Total	917 Votes
